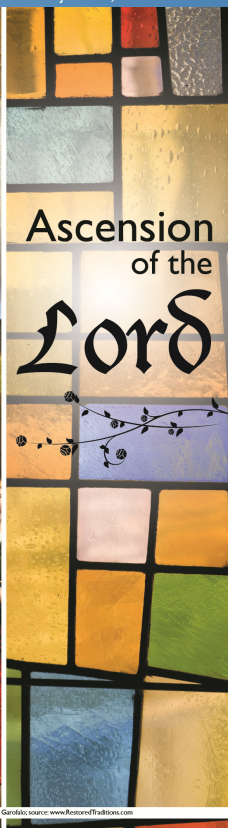

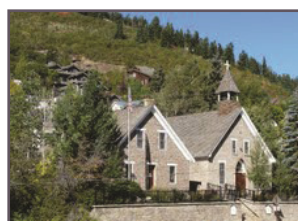

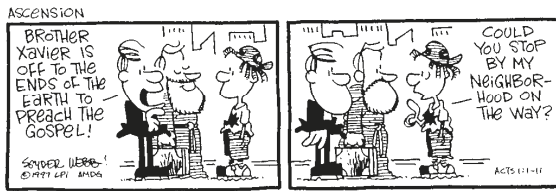
## Parish News:

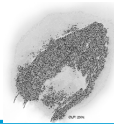

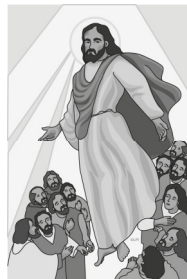

Ascensión del Señor


¿Qué tan alto es arriba? ¿Es allá dónde está el cielo? Esto me preguntaban unos niños del catecismo. Cabe reconocer que son preguntas muy profundas, ya que envuelven a la cosmología, la teología y la cristología. Entonces, ¿qué respuestas debemos dar ante tales preguntas? La primera pregunta va más allá de nuestra comprensión. La segunda no se puede limitar el cielo a la dimensión de un espacio. La pregunta que debemos de ponderar hoy más bien es la siguiente: si Jesús ascendió al cielo, ¿es allá dónde está su cuerpo? La fiesta de la Ascensión celebra un aspecto de la Resurrección; concretamente, el júbilo de la ascensión de Jesús al cielo. Él ciertamente no esperó cuarenta días para ser glorificado a la derecha del Padre. Eso sucedió inmediatamente en su resurrección. Nosotros ni siquiera en nuestra mente humana tenemos un alcance de este misterio. Dios es misterio mismo y lo creemos por nuestra fe.

Por medio de la temporada de Pascua ponemos nuestra atención en un aspecto de este misterio. En la Pascua nuestra meta es concentrarnos en la victoria de Jesús sobre la muerte y el pecado. Es por eso que hoy contemplamos su exaltación. El próximo domingo celebraremos el regalo del Espíritu Santo. Sin embargo, es bueno que en nuestra reflexión de esta semana analicemos cómo es que estamos llevando a cabo esta comisión que el Señor nos ha dejado: "Vayan por todo el mundo y prediquen el Evangelio a toda creatura". Ahora es el tiempo de ponernos de pie y contestar a la pregunta: ¿dónde está Jesús? ¿Está donde estoy yo! ¿Creo esto?



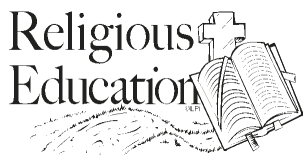
